There is a reality in our world that many people are living by and it's called *moral relativism* it is where people determine themselves what is right and wrong in their words and actions. Even apart from a religious point of view legally people can't just say and act how they feel or want if that was the case we would have no need for a legal system that is there to serve and protect people's rights. Whether people are truly responsible for their actions is another issue this gets back to what is called *culpability*. Naturally we would allow some behavior from a child that we would not allow from an adult! As Christians our attitudes and actions being morally right or wrong comes from the word of Jesus Christ and the authority that he has left his Church, this is not open to be changed if a Christian is to keep their integrity.
