So often we hear at Lent that it is the time to give something up such as not having chocolate, sugar, alcohol or cakes and the reality is that after Lent finishes we so often go back to our old ways until the next Lent! Recently Pope Francis gave an interesting reflection as to how we could do a few things in Lent that could well create a foundation to make things a lot better for ourselves and other people well beyond Lent, he wrote:

Fast from criticism of others and look for ways to Feast and affirm people.

Fast from making excuses as to why we can't do things and look for ways to Feast in finding ways to get things done for others.

Fast from being jealous of other people and Feast in being grateful for the people who come our way in life.

Fast from being anxious when things go wrong in life and Feast more in being more trusting towards God providence.

Fast from holding on to grudges and Feast more on being more reconciled with other people.

The key to succeeding in any of the above is to remember that we don't do all of these things just by our own resources but we rely also on the Holy Spirit to help us when we pray personally and with our Parish community. Why not try it and then see what can happen! - Fr Martin R Maunsell
