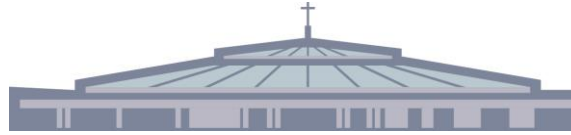

Again, when this happens it can be a time that is both lonely and difficult.

The real success of anyone's journey will be seen in the quality of the relationships that they have made with the people who have come on board with them.
