Sister IRENE McCORMACK (1938-1991)

Irene was born in a small rural WA village, in her youth she was described as vibrant, determined and fun loving. Irene was educated by the Josephite Sisters and attended their school at Santa Maria College in Perth. It was here that she developed the Josephite charism of serving God by teaching young people. She soon joined the Josephite Order soon and for the next 30 years she was both a popular and dedicated teacher and principal in their WA schools.

In 1987 Irene responded to the call to be a missionary in Latin America serving the materially poor people she was initially at Lima, then in 1989 she left to serve the people in *Huaasahuasi* high up in the Andes Mountains. She went there with a fellow Australian Josephite Dorothy Stevenson where they taught the children and distributed basic needs to the people provided by *Caritas*. Both Sisters were deeply loved and respected by the people for their care, dedication and spirituality.

A local terrorist guerrilla group known the *Sendero Luminoso* were intimidated by their popularity and influence over the local people so on the 21st of May 1991 Irene with 4 other people were brutally shot dead by a member of this group in the town plaza. Her death drew worldwide attention. She is now buried in the district and the local people regards her already as a martyr –saint, she will be forever remembered as a truly great Australian! - *Fr Martin R Maunsell.*
