Cardinal JAMES FREEMAN (1907-91)

James Darcy Freeman was the 6th Archbishop of Sydney, he like his predecessor grew up in inner Sydney his father was a tram driver he had a brother and 2 sisters one who was a Charity Sister. He was educated by the Sisters of Charity and the Christian Brothers at the Cathedral school never dreaming that he would one day return as the archbishop! James was a solid not outstanding student he enjoyed literature, music and sport especially cricket, rugby league and boxing!

Ordained (with special approval) at 22 years of age in 1930, Father Freeman initially served in the Lismore diocese, he was then the archbishop’s secretary and when made bishop in 1957 he was the Parish Priest at Stanmore. He was an auxiliary bishop in Sydney then bishop of Armidale from 1969 and returned to Sydney as archbishop in 1971, he was created a cardinal of the Church in 1973 then knighted in 1977. He participated in 2 papal conclaves both in the same year, 1978.

Cardinal Freeman as priest, bishop and cardinal was admired and loved by many people both within and outside of the Church. He is fondly remembered as a gifted orator who never used notes and was a great defender of people materially poor and marginalized. He often proclaimed the importance of a devotion to Mary the mother of God. He consistently conveyed a great inner peace and in many ways was a truly great Australian!- Fr Martin R Maunsell.
