THE HOLY SPIRIT. In the here and now!

After reading a Pentecost reflection a good friend of mine put to me these 2 questions; the first was; what exactly is the Holy Spirit? And the second question was; after accepting the reality of the Holy Spirit then how can it change our human condition? These are very challenging questions!

To begin answering the first question it is traditionally taught that the Holy Spirit is the third person of the Blessed Trinity. In breaking this down it could also be said that the Holy Spirit is God's distinctive and extraordinary power that is able to change the nature of all creation especially God's greatest creation ourselves who have been made in his own image and likeness.

In answering the second question it is helpful to remember that the third person of the Blessed Trinity is not able to change a poet into an accountant or a sprinter into a stayer! What can happen is that the power of God's Spirit with our cooperation is able to clarify and control our inner thoughts in a way that no other force can do. This reality was eloquently expressed in the words of this beautiful prayer: "Come O Holy Spirit to enable me to see things more clearly, to love others more dearly and to see Jesus more nearly." Yes the Holy Spirit is definitely invisible yet when we connect with it great things can and do happen within us! - Fr Martin R Maunsell
