REMEMBERING Dr Martin Luther KING

It was in April 1968, 50 years ago that the outstanding American civil rights leader Dr Martin Luther King Junior was assassinated yet his powerful words and witness definitely did not die with him. At the time of his death he was only 39 years of age and was married to Coretta they were blessed with 4 children. Due to a number of factors the marriage was in constant turmoil so privately and publically life for this family was on a human roller coaster. Dr King is credited with giving some of the most important and memorable speeches recorded not just in American history but in world history! He came onto the public stage in 1955 when he helped organise a boycott of buses in the town of Montgomery, Alabama after the colored seamstress Rosa Parks created a national sensation by refusing to give up her seat at the demand of a white passenger. This action was a spark that lit a fire that has never really gone out. Below are some of the more memorable quotes publically broadcast from this brave and wise leader;

- *Our lives really begin on the day we choose not to be silent about things that really matter.*
- *Love is the only force that is capable of turning an enemy in to a friend.*
- *Injustice anywhere is a threat to justice everywhere.*
- *Faith is taking the first step even when we can't see the whole staircase.*
