A TRINITY REFLECTION, 2017

“Baptize them in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and teach them to observe all of the commands that I have given you.” (Matthew Chapter 28, verse 19-20)

The Trinity has always been a religious mystery in that we believe in faith that it exists but how it has evolved, how it is sustained and how far that it encompasses is beyond any possible human comprehension.

The best way to convey the principle of the existence of the Trinity is to relate it to a human metaphor. The best metaphor that I have ever come across is that of an *orchestra* where we can liken the people who play the instruments to the *Son* the instruments themselves are likened to God the *Father* and the sounds that come from the played instruments are like God the *Holy Spirit*. It is never the right question to ever ask if one is more important than the other as without any of them then the orchestra would not be able to at all exist. Another way of looking at this mystery is to think of it very much like 3 different candles all lit that convey the same light that illuminates a room. - Fr Martin R Maunsell
