A GREAT AUSTRALIAN CATHOLIC WOMAN, CAROLINE CHISHOLM (1808-77)

This extraordinary woman was born in Northampton, England in 1808 to Protestant parents, she in time married Captain Archbold Chisholm in 1830 and then in 1832 they moved to Madras, India. Caroline always had a great desire to serve the needs of the less fortunate people wherever she went, and in time under the influence of her husband she became a devoted Catholic.

While on extended leave Caroline with her husband and now 3 sons came to Sydney, Australia in 1838 where she saw a deep need to support the many frightened migrant people arriving in Australia. Caroline was a familiar figure of welcome on the wharves of Sydney and lobbied the Government to give the migrant people more opportunities to settle then what they were already giving.

She is best described in these words; "A russet haired, tall sweet voiced woman who when confronted with unfair or indifferent officialdom suddenly became an uncompromising radical in seeing people being given a fair go. She at the same time was a devoted wife and mother who especially sought to give dignity to woman in a harsh society by her courage and idealism mixed with her executive ability and personal charm."

When the Chisholm family finally returned to England in 1854 she still agitated the English Government for better transport and living conditions for migrants. She died in 1877 and will be fondly remembered as "the immigrant's friend."-Fr Martin R Maunsell
