#### ***Fr (Dr) WILLIAM ULLATHORNE (1806-1809)***

Before Sydney was a diocese the care of Australia was under the responsibility of the Bishop of Mauritius, who I am sure never came to see what he was responsible for!

Having no resident Church authority figure in Australia this created problems with title deeds and land grants so a vicar general was appointed who arrived in 1833 and his name was *Fr William Ullathorne*. He held that position until 1835 when Bishop Polding arrived to be the official bishop. Fr Ullathorne was greeted with respect and probably with great anxiety by the 2 free resident priests Fathers Therry and McEncroe.

Father Ullathorne was an English Benedictine priest who was given the official title as *His Majesty’s Catholic Chaplain of NSW*, he soon became well known in his travels around Sydney and rural areas. Upon the arrival of Bishop Polding in 1835 he worked as his secretary and companion, he then returned to England via Rome in 1837. While Fr Ullathorne was in Rome he gave the Vatican authorities a favorable report of the Church within Australia and because of his past studies was awarded a *Doctor of Theology* by Pope Gregory XVI.

Upon returning to England the now Dr Ullathorne recruited 13 young Irish priests as well as some Sisters of Charity to return with him to Australia in 1838. He again returned to England permanently in 1840 where he later became the Archbishop of Birmingham in 1850, he died 23<sup>rd</sup> of March, 1889 aged 83 years. *Fr Martin R Maunsell*
