A PENTECOST REFLECTION

“The wind blows where it wills, and you can hear the sound it makes, but you do not know where it comes from or where it goes, so it is with everyone born of the Spirit.” (John Ch. 3 verse 8)

A man who for years struggled with alcohol addiction decided to do something about it by committing himself to attending the local Alcohol Anonymous meeting.

After a while one of his old drinking mates ridiculed him by saying; “Surely you don’t believe in all of this religious stuff about Jesus turning water into wine?” The now ex-drunk said with great conviction; “Well I can’t speak about that from personal experience but I do know that there is a power stronger than me who has turned the money that I once spent on alcohol into food on the table for me and my family.”

This answer fits perfectly into what Jesus of Nazareth meant when he said that we can’t see the wind around us but we can hear its sound and also appreciate where it is coming from. On this Pentecost weekend where we celebrate the birthday of the Church and the powerful coming of the Holy Spirit upon the early disciples we may well ask ourselves where we have felt the power of God’s spirit change our lives for the better. - Fr Martin R Maunsell
